The Board of Supervisors will consider a Special Use Permit application from Kenny Dotson, on behalf of LGTC 4 LLC, to allow an increase in the maximum square footage of signage permitted for a tenant in the Locust Grove Town Center, with the specific unit located at 6241 Constitution Highway, Locust Grove. The property is identified as Tax Map Parcel 22-120, contains 2.55 acres, and is zoned General Commercial (C-2) Conditional. The property is situated in the Village Recommended Future Land Use category, as described in the Orange County Comprehensive Plan.

- b. Vacation of Subdivision Plat: *Thomas Lacheney, County Attorney*
The Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of an Ordinance to vacate a Subdivision Plat for "Southfork Plantation III," pursuant to Section 15.2-2271 of the Code of Virginia. The subject property, owned by Gerald Hoy, is identified as Tax Map Parcels 48-8-1 through 48-8-12 and is located along Route 522 (Zachary Taylor Highway), Unionville. Said plat is recorded as Instrument 230001392 in Plat Cabinet S, Pages 80 and 81 in the Orange County Circuit Court Clerk's Office.
