The Board of Supervisors will consider an application from Signature Series Development, LLC, to rezone property at the intersection of Germanna Highway (Route 3) and Somerset Ridge Road (Route 708), Locust Grove, currently zoned as Planned Development - Mixed-Use (PDM) Conditional, to amend the proffered

design standards regarding signs. The property is identified as Tax Map Parcel 4-3 and contains approximately 75.8 acres. The property is situated in the Germanna-Wilderness Area Plan (GWAP) Recommended Future Land Use category, as described in the Orange County Comprehensive Plan.
